Resource List for Persons Living with HIV Infection in the Miami Valley/Dayton Consortium #4 area

It is important to keep a 2 week supply of your medication on hand and keep a regular schedule of care appointments for visiting your health care provider:

- It is recommended that you visit your doctor every 4 to 6 months
- It is recommended that you have your blood drawn to monitor your viral load and 7-cell about every 3 to 4 months
- It is best to seek treatment for depression and substance abuse problems

To get your medications refilled:

- Call your pharmacist to speak to your physician's office for needed refills
- Call your case manager at AIDS Resource Center, Case Management office at 937-461-2437 or 800-252-0827.
- Call your physician or clinic office refill line

Support groups and educational groups are another way to learn how to stay healthy with HIV.

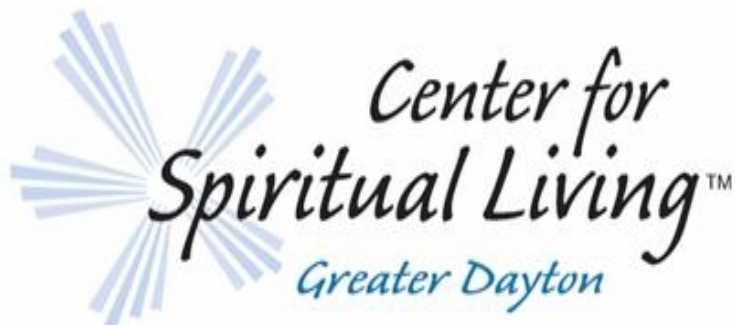



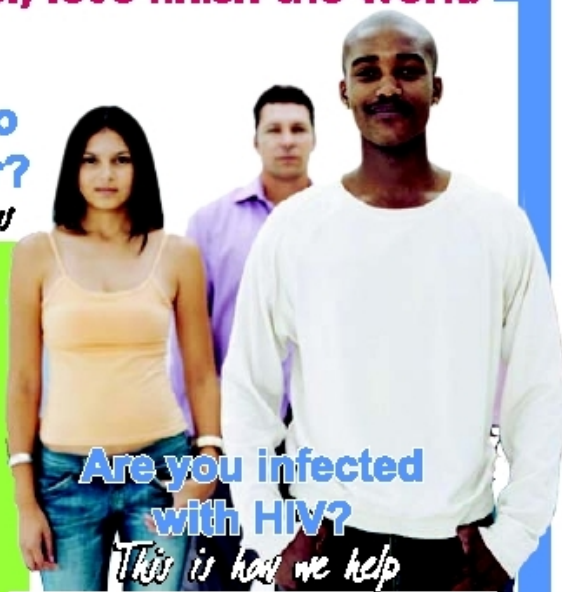
